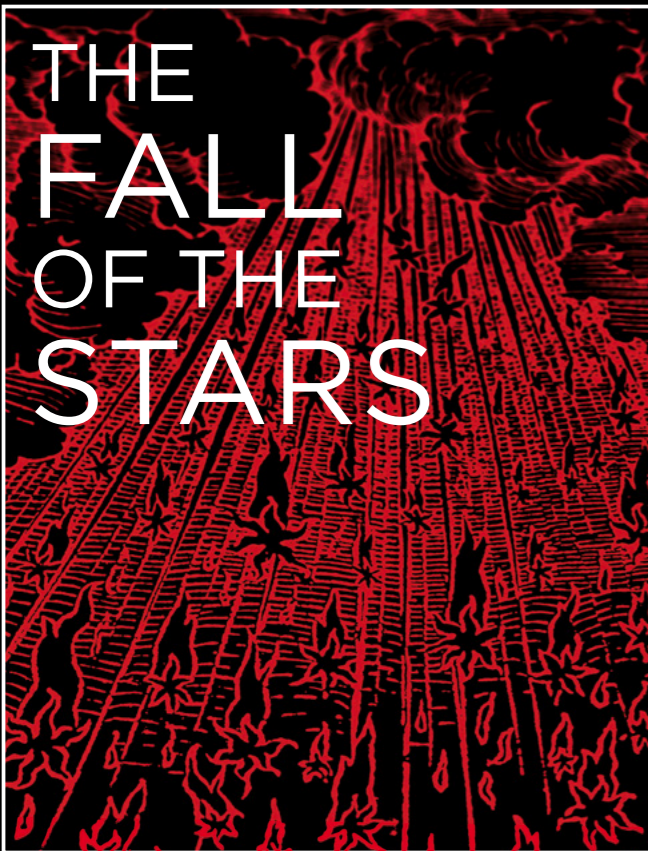

## THE FALL OF THE STARS | 18.03.–26.08.2018

Apocalyptic conceptions of the end of the world have fascinated mankind for centuries. This exhibition brings together two pictorially powerful visions of the end of time: Julian Rosefeldt's work *In the Land of Drought* and Albrecht Dürer's illustrations for the Book of Revelations. In his video installation, Julian Rosefeldt (born in 1965) depicts an imaginary post-apocalyptic future in which people are inescapably confronted with the consequences of the overexploitation of the Earth's resources. More than five hundred years before Rosefeldt created his work, Albrecht Dürer (1471–1528) illustrated the Bible's foretelling of the end of the world with fifteen woodcuts. First published in 1498, the fanciful yet fear-inducing series responded to the mood of gloom and doom that prevailed as the turn of the century approached. Roughly contemporaneous with Dürer's series is a Dutch printed edition of the eschatological proclamations by the theologian Jean Gerson (1363–1429). This little book, which is illustrated with fifteen naive, vivid sequences of pictures, is a practical demonstration of how people were supposed to envision the portents of the end of the world and the Last Judgment.

As different as the works by Rosefeldt, Dürer, and Gerson may seem, they do have one thing in common: the vision of an end of the world that can be understood not as the final end but rather as the beginning of something new, of a world after the world. The exhibition invites visitors to enter this field of tension between creation, destruction, and new beginning and to envision the imaginable worlds of different futures.

A publication in German, English, and Dutch accompanies the exhibition.
